HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND OSAEC ONLINE AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS

Every year, Captivating reaches around 40,000 people through classroom and community-based education on human trafficking and Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC). But many of the girls most at risk live in remote communities that traditional outreach cannot reach.

Our **new targeted online campaigns** are helping us take prevention beyond the classroom—reaching thousands of girls, families, and communities with vital information and connecting those at risk to support.

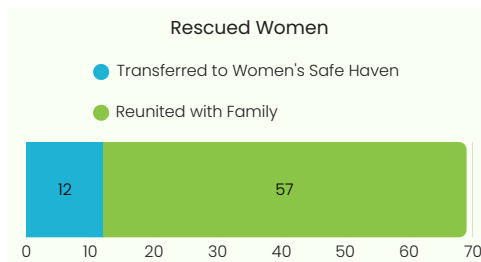


ANTI-HUMAN TRAFFICKING MONITORING STATIONS

- 1,587** women intercepted
- 69** women rescued at the border or brothels
- 1,081** students from 16 schools participated in the Hamro Abhiyan Anti-Human Trafficking Program
- 504** community members reached through trafficking awareness programs
- 363** women received free legal support
- 44** cases of domestic violence reported

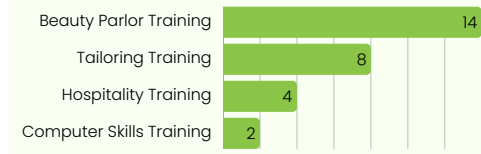


Nearly **1 in 5 women** interviewed were identified as being at risk of trafficking.



WOMEN'S SAFE HAVEN AND VOCATIONAL CENTERS

- 6** women and girls are currently supported
- 28** women have successfully reintegrated into their communities and reunited with their families



The reintegrated women received counselling, medical care, and skills training.

MY BUSINESS - MY FREEDOM MICROFINANCE PROGRAM

- 1,030** women's groups members
- 582** women currently with microloans
- 117** new women joined the program
- 159** women left the program successful



CAPTIVATING VILLAGE PROGRAM - IN PARTNERSHIP WITH 3 ANGELS NEPAL

- 1,239** girls have been helped since the program began in 2022
- 231** current scholars supported
- 28** girls graduated grade 12 since 2022

78% SEE Passing Rate

The Secondary Education Examination or SEE is the final government exam at the end of Grade 10 and determines whether students can continue to higher secondary education.

Targeted mathematics and science lessons helped our scholars more than double their SEE pass rate from **38% to 78%** in just three months.

MILESTONE

- Concluded 3 village programs**
After three years, **176** girls including 6 grade 12 graduates were able to finish the program.

CAPTIVATING VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM - IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CAPTIVATING NEPAL

- 395** current scholars supported
- 110** women empowered through livelihood initiatives
- 365** community members received vital health support
- 1,047** reached through trafficking and drug-abuse awareness
- 120** supported with emergency relief after devastating fires

MILESTONES

- Launched our fifth village program**
- Concluded our first village program**
- 145** Local government and stakeholders engaged in program review and knowledge sharing
- 510** Youth and students reached through trafficking prevention and awareness activities
- 1,312** Girls supported through education, capacity building, and school-based initiatives
- 4,709** Reached through reproductive and mental health awareness, and free health camps
- 188** Community members supported to increase household income through skills and livelihood opportunities
- 27** Individuals and families supported through emergency response assistance

After seven months of Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) classes, **115 of 120** girls successfully returned to formal education, with school entrance exams helping determine the highest appropriate grade based on their learning level.

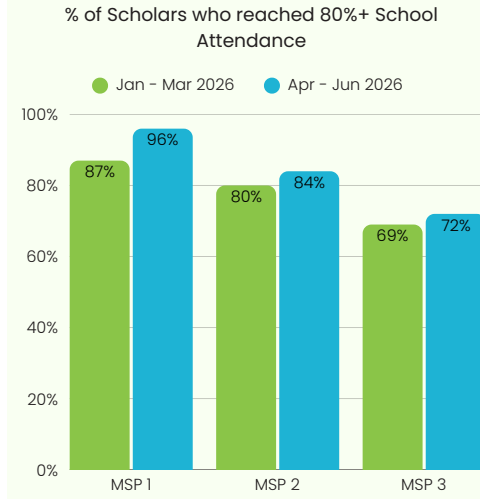

MANILA SLUM PROGRAM

- 553** scholars educated

MILESTONES

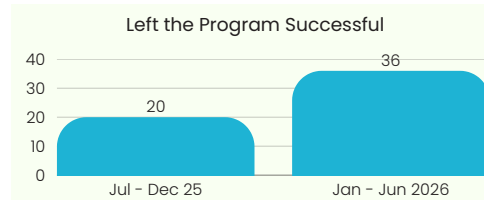
- **Concluded our first MSP community**
Three years ago, many students regularly missed school. Today, **96%** of scholars achieve 80%+ attendance.
- **Launched our fourth MSP community**
215 scholars are back in school after the launch in August 2026.



School attendance is improving each quarter.

ONE HOPE MICROFINANCE PROGRAM

- 1,192** mothers supported through microfinance
- 52** new women joined the program
- 36** women left the program successful



Women successfully transitioning out of microfinance increased by **80%**.

STOP CYBERSEX CRIME: AWARENESS AND EDUCATION PROGRAM

- 17,904** students and community members joined awareness sessions on Online Sexual Abuse or Exploitation of Children (OSAEC)
- 237** new community advocates equipped to report and prevent cases of OSAEC

BLESSED HOUSE PROJECT

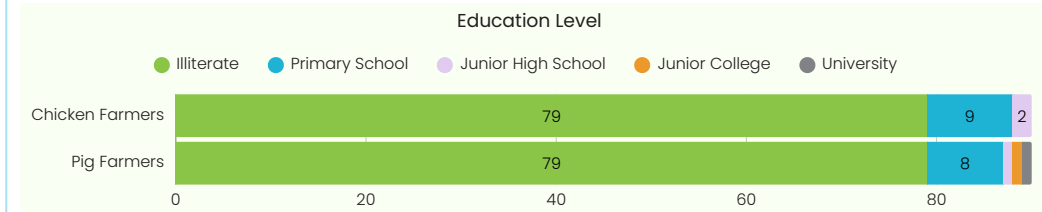
- 18** survivors of OSAEC or trafficking are currently supported
- 3** survivors successfully reintegrated with their families and communities

CHICKEN AND PIG FARMING PROGRAM

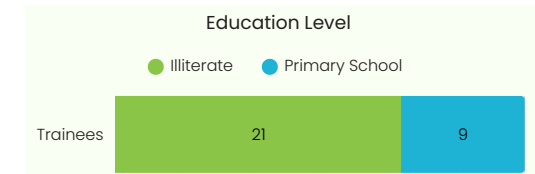
- 90** women undergoing chicken farming training
- 90** women undergoing pig farming training
- 100%** of the 180 households who completed the 2025 farming programs plan to continue farming



For **88%** of trainees who have had no formal schooling, the farming program is creating new opportunities to earn a living and build a better future for their families.

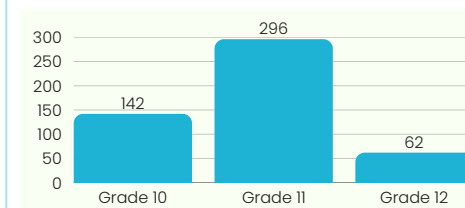
HUSKY ENERGY TAILORING SKILLS PROGRAM FOR WOMEN

- 30** women started their 3-month tailoring training in June
- 70%** of trainees have no formal education, while primary school is the highest level attained.



ONE MORE YEAR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

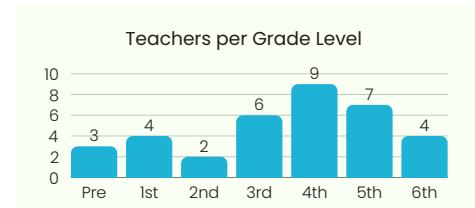
- 500** girls from rural villages supported through scholarships



100% of Grade 12 scholars graduated in July.

SEND A VOLUNTEER TEACHER PROGRAM
