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MESSAGE FROM THE Founders

To our amazing supporters and partners,

It's with a great sense of pride and admiration that we take a moment to step back and review the work and impact Captivating International has had in the world for 2022. As we do most years, we conclude by simply saying how blessed we are with amazing on-the-ground implementing partners, dedicated staff, supportive boards, and of course all underpinned by a stable and generous donor base.

It's because of all of you, Captivating was able to again impact the lives of an estimated 15,000 girls, young women, struggling moms and their children. These lives have materially and significantly improved either through having their education stabilized, family incomes increased, or being saved from a catastrophic event such as becoming a victim of human trafficking. A further 50,000 people felt the imprint of Captivating on their worlds through our education and awareness programs.

The great news is that 2023 is shaping up to be even better. As we write this, expansion programs are happening across all 3 countries where Captivating is focused. If you are reading this as a financial contributor to our work, we say a huge thank you to you.





This Simply Captivating report is an overview of the combined results of Captivating International Foundation Limited (Hong Kong registered), Captivating Australia and Captivating USA. All are registered charities in their countries and compliant with NGO country requirements. Captivating is also partnered with the Global Development Group who are experts in international development programs charged with the responsibility of ensuring our programs are of the best quality and compliant with international development best practice.

2022 was an action-packed year but, in many respects, was also a year of jumping through flaming hoops due to the tail-end of COVID. From a fundraising perspective, our support base was solid overall. Because we report globally in US dollars, we did suffer from a strong US dollar for the second half of 2022. That, combined with difficulty running all our fundraising events in China due to COVID restrictions, resulted in an overall 7% decline in total donations. However, we were able to still see our total programs increase and expand due to funding surpluses from previous years.

We were also pleased to achieve, for the first time, the goal of having 100% of our administration, fundraising and program support costs funded thanks to dedicated Captivating partners and events. This has been a goal of ours since Captivating began.

Finally, it was a real thrill for Julie and myself to finally get back to visiting some of our programs in Nepal in February/March. Based in Nepal for almost a month, we were able to reengage directly with our implementing partners. It confirmed for us, once again, how dedicated and passionate these on-the-ground people are to bringing hope and freedom to precious lives. We are thrilled to be doing this with them. All of our partners across the Philippines, China, and Nepal have our huge admiration for what they do each and every day.

Blessings to all of you who read this report. We have plans to do SO MUCH MORE in the world - year after year. After 15 years, we now know we have the programs and the relationships we need in place. FINANCIAL REVIEW



TOTAL REVENUE

Revenue was down following limitations on our Asia based charity fundraising events due to Covid restrictions as well as foreign currency fluctuations and the extra-ordinary strength of the US dollar. Some regular corporate donors also scaled back due to a challenging business period. This revenue includes all related entities/partners. We were extremely thankful to our generous donors and partners continuing to support Captivating.



FUNDS DIRECT TO PROGRAMS

This was up in 2022 due to our implementing partners being able to continue their programs in full after their limited ability during COVID. We were also able to implement additional projects and programs. It is expected 2023 program rollouts will remain consistent and in line with expectations.



PROJECT SUPPORT COSTS

Similar % of total expenses to the previous year. Captivating staff continued to meet online on a regular basis with project partners to discuss planning, audit, and review of projects.



CORPORATE SERVICES

As expected from last year, in 2022 the % of corporate services costs (which is expressed as a % of total expenses) **reduced** thanks to increased program implementations as well as decreasing fundraising and marketing costs in 2022. This is full credit to our Captivating staff. A great result.


SURPLUS FOR THE YEAR

On a global Captivating basis, there was a surplus of over US\$167,000 due to a reduction in fundraising and marketing costs and higher than expected revenue against expenses. This continues to put us in a great position for program expansion in 2023. We're certainly off to a good start. We are excited about the future and being able to use these additional funds to further increase the capacity of support to marginalised women and children in vulnerable situations.

Intercepting Girls

A Nepali girl is trafficked every 17 minutes, making the work of our seven monitoring stations critical in the fight against trafficking. Evidence from such monitoring stations often leads to charges being laid against the suspected traffickers.

In 2022, trained personnel with government approval at Captivating funded monitoring stations stopped 16,349 women in transit to other locations (mostly into India). They were interviewed because their circumstances looked suspicious. These interviews resulted in 5,518 women and girls being stopped from going to their intended destinations because of serious concern they were being trafficked. Their families were contacted to pick them up from our centers where they were all provided counseling, information about the warning signs and dangers of trafficking, and risks of crossing the border from Nepal into, India. This essential information is crucial for prevention. 1,023 girls were also referred to the police because of hard evidence found that might help in the conviction of traffickers. Trusting natures and desperation for a better life are vulnerabilities on which traffickers capitalize.





Descre and raids



In 2022, raid operations in Nepal and India resulted in 57 girls and women being rescued from hotels and brothels. Despite the dangers, our team is committed to rescuing girls from these terrifying circumstances. Thorough and cautious planning and coordination with local authorities, government officials and our team allowed for careful execution, ensuring these girls were returned to safety.

When our teams rescue a girl, they help her reclaim her life and provide nurturing support through counseling, medical and legal aid, and with the opportunity to pursue legal justice against her perpetrators.

Counselling * LEGAL HELP

To address the pervasive injustices in Nepal, our teams are present in communities to help vulnerable people with legal support and advice. Our teams work tirelessly to speak for those unable to do so for themselves and provide them with the knowledge to empower themselves. We cooperate with the Nepali legal system and police to bring justice to those who have suffered from abuse. Each trafficker we apprehend means fewer girls are being purchased and exploited, which is the ultimate victory for justice. In 2022, 505 women received legal assistance, resulting in the arrest of 65 traffickers.

Pommunity BROADCASTING

With a strong focus on reaching and educating the Nepali community, The 3 Angels Community Radio Program (3ACR) has been broadcasting since 2013, and introduced the 3ACR app to expand their reach. In 2022, 134,100 active listeners tuned into the Captivating-funded radio broadcast app that educates listeners and watchers about human trafficking, violence against women, legal advice, and counseling support. The team's effort to engage with the community has allowed them to deliver essential information on relevant local topics, bring people together, and create a sense of belonging.



In total, an estimated 500,000 people regularly tune in to the broadcast. This is having an immeasurable effect on keeping Nepali's safe, educated and aware.

MY BUSINESS Freedom MICROFINANCE PROGRAM

Our My Business My Freedom microfinance program implemented in partnership with 3 Angels Nepal now empowers 582 women by providing them with a support system, training, mentorship, and a microloan to start a small business. This helps them become self-sufficient and reduces the likelihood of them or their children/grandchildren falling prey to traffickers taking advantage of their vulnerability. By equipping women with business skills, the program guides them to establish businesses and experience financial independence while allowing them to become role models in their communities and set an example for their children.





HAMRO ABHIYAN

ANTI-TRAFFICKING AWARENESS PROGRAM

The Hamro Abhiyan program focuses on creating a greater understanding of human trafficking and dispelling cultural prejudices and misunderstandings that exist. Focused on students from schools in areas considered more at-risk of human trafficking due to their poverty, the interactive nature of the program encourages open discussions of real-life issues and provides valuable information aimed at decreasing the potential of attendees falling victim to either trafficking or cybersex crime. It also helps attendees understand how to identify potential abuse happening in their communities and how to report it. This program has gained significant support from the government and in addition to running the training at 55 schools, educating 4,575 students, the program was also attended by 200 Nepali police and army personnel. This program continues to go from strength to strength thanks to the amazing implementing team at 3 Angels Nepal.

women's Safe Haven

In 2022, the Women's Safe Haven provided shelter and support to 93 young women and girls who were abandoned by their families or communities due to trafficking, rape, or unwanted pregnancy. The Safe Haven provides medical attention, counselling services, and tailored support in a secure and comfortable environment that helps these girls navigate their trauma, overcome their fears and doubts, and create a strategy for rebuilding their lives. Part of this strategy includes training in a particular skill that would enable them to earn a living and gain independence.

In 2022, 70 young women and girls participated in learning skills such tailoring, baking, and shoemaking to equip them for employment opportunities. Therapy sessions incorporated painting and banglemaking to aid in their healing process. With a newfound sense of self, the girls leave the Safe Haven stronger, more confident, and with a purpose as they move into their next chapter.

CAPTIVATING Village Project



Because of our new Captivating Village Project in Nepal, 171 girls from 15 separate village projects are back in school. Our research shows that stabilizing education - keeping every girl in school for as long as possible – is one of the most impactful ways to save them from the desperation of extreme poverty, which is a primary risk factor in becoming a victim of human trafficking, child labor, and child marriage. In partnership with 3 Angels Nepal and Aasaman Nepal, we continue to discover girls who are not in school because of poverty, so our purpose to educate girls and empower communities is expanding to where it's needed most.

Our thanks to our amazing individual and family donors who have been willing to stand behind each one of these Village Programs. Together, we are now helping secure the futures of so many children and many of their families.

The successful transition of our Vocational School Scholarship program into the ONE MORE YEAR Program provided a more extensive reach in 2022 and impacted an additional 100 students and their families who needed our help.

The Captivating ONE MORE YEAR program partners with highschools and vocational schools located in marginalized remote/rural areas where families find it difficult to see their girls through to graduation. These families are under so much financial stress, and this stress falls on the shoulders of these girls who feel guilty their education is causing their parents to make even more sacrifices. We find the poorest-of-the-poor students in our partner schools and provide them much needed support (both financial and emotional). Our aim is to see these girls go as far as they can and not quit.

In 2022, 600 students across Yunnan, Sichuan, Guizhou, and Guangxi where able to confidently continue their education thanks to OMY. This was possible due to our partnership with 17 senior high or vocational schools. These girls are selected based on previous academic performance, personal drive for growth, past teacher recommendations, and significant financial need. Despite their different academic paths, all these students share common aspirations of pursuing careers that make a significant difference in the world.

My First Job

In 2022, 102 women from underserved and remote areas in China successfully graduated from the My First Job Embroidery Program. These women lacked educational opportunities and were seeking stable employment options. By equipping them with valuable skills, the program offers life-changing opportunities for a steady career and financial stability. For most, this is the first certificate they have ever received, and it is valued and cherished with sincere gratitude.





TAILORING SKILLS PROGRAM

In 2022, the Husky Energy Tailoring Skills for Women program had 49 graduates. Lasting for three months, the program provided participants with valuable skills that led to empowerment, confidence, and income-generating opportunities. After completing the course, some graduates enter the workforce by securing employment in local sewing stores, while others start small businesses from the comfort of their homes which allows them to attend to their children's needs.

Our thanks to Husky Energy (now a member of the Cenovus group of companies), for making this program possible, now for the 5th year.

Volunteer Teacher

PROGRAM

Teacher shortages are prevalent in schools in the remote mountains of Sichuan because of the region's harsh weather and isolation. However, with the help of the Support a Volunteer Teacher Program, 1236 students in these schools have been receiving an improved education all thanks to an amazing, dedicated volunteer teacher coming to their school.

In 2022 we were able to increase the number of volunteer teachers from 15 to 30. These teachers do not receive any salary, but without help with basic needs like food, accommodation, and transportation, these teachers would likely not be able to do what's on their hearts - to educate children who will otherwise miss out. While some volunteer teachers only stay for a term, the majority choose to stay longer because of the progress they witness and the relationships they form with their students. They make this amazing sacrifice for these elementary level students because they know that it's a solid early education foundation that sets the scene for all that follows. These teachers are real life heroes.

OSAEC stands for Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children. The Philippines ranks as the #1 country in the world for cyber-sex crime against children. This is a horrible statistic we aim to change. In partnership with The Honor 1000 Movement and their growing network of program partners, we are implementing education and awareness programs in those areas assessed as being most at risk of OSAEC.

Training includes distributing infographic materials in schools, educating community members, holding focus group discussions, and creating engagement for online campaigns.

In 2022 we reached 38,269 individuals with critical messages of online safety and how to report abuses. These efforts in the Philippines demonstrate an unwavering commitment to improving the lives of those most at risk, particularly in the face of unprecedented circumstances.



HONOR 1000

Microfinance PROGRAM

This microfinance program directly addresses extreme poverty to reduce the lure of engaging in high-risk behaviors of migration to find work, falling prey to the sex industry, or participating in the exploitation of children online. 1,996 women participated in the Microfinance program in the Philippines in 2022, where they received starting capital in the form of a loan so they could start or expand their small businesses. They also learned how to manage their income and create savings in sustainable ways to increase operational independence and accountability.

This kind of learning is not only beneficial for the financial situations of these families, but instills a sense of pride, capability, and accomplishment among women in high-risk areas which contributes to enhanced community-wide stability and growth.

These 1,996 women are not only improving their own lives, but those of their immediate families (specifically their children or grandchildren). Our best estimate is that 8,000 lives are benefitting through this program. That's 8,000 lives less prone to the dangers of Cybersex crime or human trafficking.

Blessed House

Captivating's planned phasing out of financial support of The Blessed House project came to a close December 2022 after 4 years of support. We are happy to share that by the time Captivating's financial support of The Blessed House came to a close, the team was able to help 15 women and dependents reintegrate into their families or other caring environments. This includes six OSAEC survivors referred to us during the pandemic. All are continuing with their education and employment, and we will continue to assist them in their legal cases and extend further support to the relatives. The team at project partner, The Honor 1000 Movement, will continue to monitor their progress.



Captualing EVENTS





In January 2022, we hosted THE WORKOUT CHALLENGE, a global event that brought together 230 participants from 10 countries, forming 28 teams. Their shared goal was to complete 5,000 reps over the month. After lots of sweat and muscle building, we were able to raise US\$20K (AU\$28K) to support our efforts in combating human trafficking in Nepal and the Philippines.
